They scheduled their meetings at noon on Tuesday.

During the years of '81 and '82, they chose a name, created a mission statement and recruited members. Since then, they have attracted new members and have had some really fascinating programs dealing with not only women's business issues, but also physical and mental health, literary topics, and children, all while maintaining the purpose of networking and friendship.
